A beautifully balanced sweet wine with luscious fruit and a lively balancing freshness. This is the 2nd wine from Chateau Suduiraut and is immense value for money



Aromas of citrus and green apple – the palate is broad and structural with more apple flavours, hints of lemon and a refreshing minerality
